2. Criteria - each applicant must:

- a) have graduated from a high school in BC or Yukon.
- b) be in final year of:
 - i. French Professional Development Program at a recognized university, or
 - ii. In professional year in a Bachelor of Education degree at a recognized university or university college,
AND have completed at least one practicum in a French Immersion setting
AND have at least two letters of reference verifying an acceptable standard of French.
- c) Indicate in writing an intent to teach French Immersion in BC or the Yukon
- d) Be a current member of Canadian Parents for French

3. Preference will be given to candidates who:

- a) Demonstrate sound academic record
- b) Participate in community affairs using the French language
- c) Demonstrate an aptitude for teaching

4. Please submit:
- a) This completed application form
 - b) A letter addressed to the Bursary Committee outlining experience in the following areas:
 - A description of work or volunteer experience with youth
 - A description of participation in community affairs using French
 - A description of the candidate's goals
 - c) Proof of graduation from a BC or Yukon high school (preference may be given to an FSL graduate, either Immersion or Core)
 - d) Proof of acceptance into a French PDP at a recognized university **OR** Proof of acceptance into a recognized Bachelor of Education Program,
 - e) Two letters of reference or practicum reports verifying an acceptable competency in the French language from your professors or immersion teachers.
 - f) Current transcript from university
